Alto Scholarship Program Revised 07/01/22

BACKGROUND:

The Alto Scholarship was created to support the emerging workforce in Escambia County by allowing them to work at Alto while pursuing postsecondary education at Coastal Alabama Community College.

PURPOSE:

To support the emerging workforce in Escambia County by providing the opportunity to simultaneously work part time at Alto and pursue and postsecondary education with Coastal Alabama Community College.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants must be graduates and or residents of South Alabama or Northwest Florida.

Award Winners must be pursuing a technical program (certificate or degree) from Coastal Alabama. The program must be approved by Alto.

Award Winners must work a minimum of 20 hours per week at Alto. Failure to meet attendance guidelines will result in the loss of the scholarship. Alto will attempt to offer the most flexible schedule available to accommodate the course schedule. The final scheduled will be determined by Alto.

Award winners must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours and maintain a minimum 3.0 grade point average. The Scholarship will cover a maximum of 60 Credit Hours.

Each award winner is required to submit a grade report for the period for which the scholarship is awarded. The report will be considered if the recipient applies for the scholarship again in the future.

Award Winners must be admitted students to Coastal Alabama Community College and have completed the FASFA with Financial Aid. Once any Pell Grants or other scholarships are applied to the students account the Alto Scholarship will pay the remaining balance of tuition and fees only. Any amount over the remaining balance will be refunded to Alto.

Employment with Alto is voluntarily entered into, and the employee is free to resign at will at any time, with or without cause. Similarly, Alto may terminate the employment relationship at will at any time, with or without notice or cause. The termination of employment by either party will result in the termination of the scholarship.

CRITERIA: Applicants will be selected based on the following:

- Commitment to employment
- Enrollment in Technical Program
- Personal character

AWARDS:

Scholarship Range: \$5,000 annually (the total award is divided into separate payments over two semesters)

The scholarship disbursement shall be made directly to the educational institution for the benefit of the scholarship recipient. The scholarship must be utilized within one year of the date of the award.

Submit an essay about your work ethics and why this opportunity to pursue employment and education simultaneously fits your career goals.

Include a letter of recommendation from your academic dean, advisor, counselor, or teacher.

Candidates must submit a completed application no later than 30 days prior to the start of the semester.
